The festival, which has been a tradition since 1929, attracts thousands of tourists each year, making it one of the best springtime events in the Midwest!

The main attraction is **De Zwaan**, a historic Dutch windmill that was brought from the Netherlands in 1964 and is the only authentic, working Dutch windmill in the United States. In the spring, the gardens come alive with thousands of colorful tulips, making it a highlight of the Tulip Time Festival. The park also features Dutch-style buildings, canals, a hand-painted antique carousel, and costumed guides who share stories about Dutch culture. Whether you're there for the flowers, history, or peaceful scenery, Windmill Island Gardens is a must-visit spot!
